The Collaborative Campus Challenge Fund will support enhanced collaboration in and around Inverness Campus. The fund is targeted primarily at academic institutions with an interest in the region. All applications should explain clearly the anticipated outputs of the funded collaboration. The fund is open to all sectors, with an anticipated bias towards Life Sciences in line with the Inverness Campus Development Strategy. Submissions demonstrating strong leverage in terms of match funding or "in kind" resource will also be favoured, with a minimum 50% match being sought in each case. Normally HIE funding will be restricted to a maximum of £15,000 per proposal.
