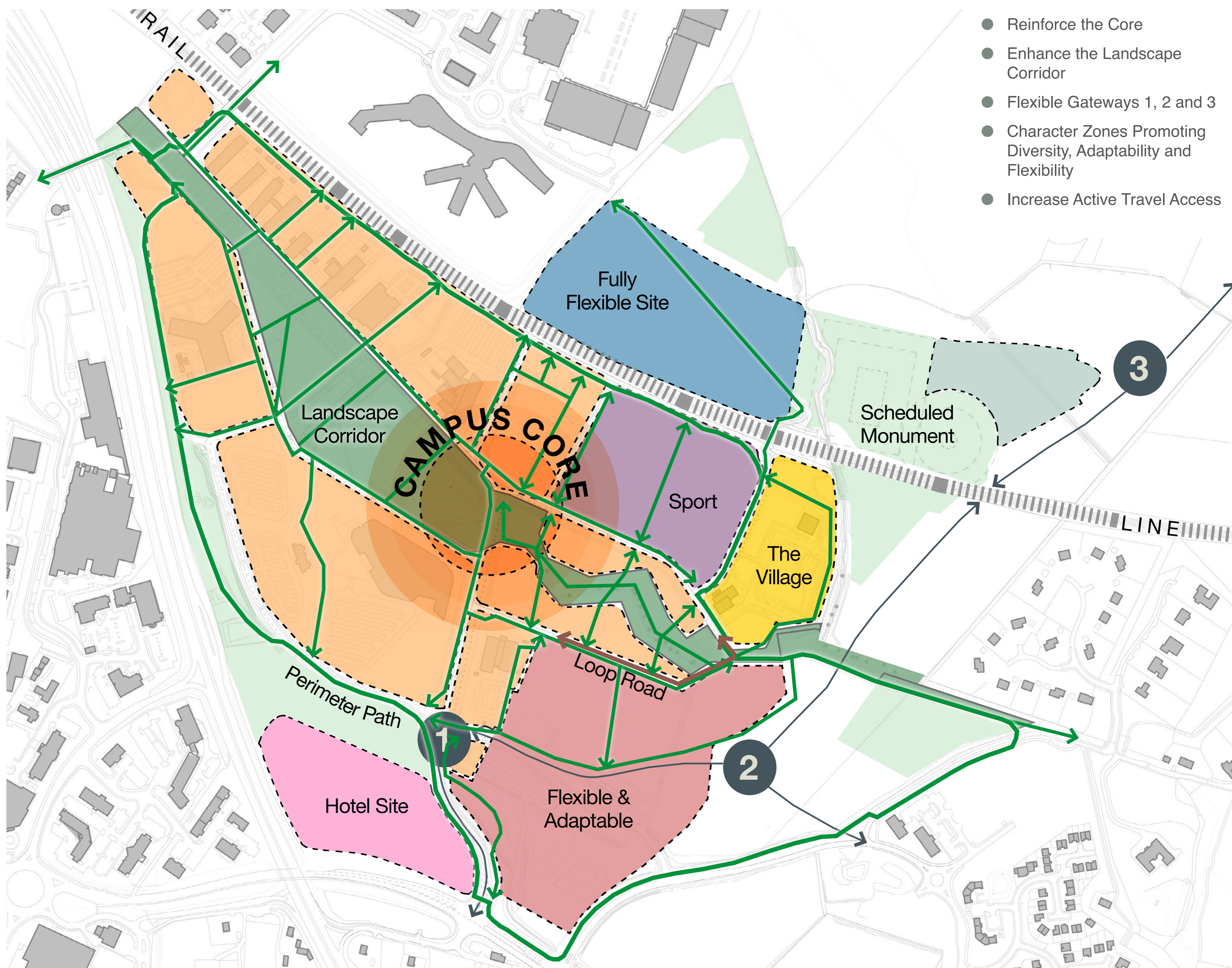

Maintaining design quality

We are delighted to hear your feedback that the first phase of Inverness Campus has been delivered to a high quality, creating a fantastic environment for those working, studying, and living at the Campus to enjoy.

It was noted by several respondents that the high-quality public realm and the green infrastructure provide an important recreational asset. This is not only for those working and living at the Campus, but also for visitors, particularly the community in the eastern part of Inverness. It was noted that the Campus provides 'international quality routes for race and road running' which are used by elite athletes.

Many of those who provided feedback emphasised the need for this high standard of design quality to be taken forward through the second phase of development. This was considered critical to the continued success of the Campus both as a location for economic development and as a community asset.

To address this we will work collaboratively with The Highland Council to prepare an updated 'Design Guidelines' for Phase 2, setting out requirements for plots, public realm, and open space to ensure that Phase 2 maintains the high quality delivered in Phase 1.
